



E-10 Blended Fuel Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is E-10?

A. 10% Ethanol, 90% Gasoline

Q. Why did you change?

A. The terminal where we purchase our gasoline changed to only offering E-10.

Q. Can I use E10 in my car?

A. E10 can be used in any gasoline powered vehicle without any modifications to the engine or fuel system.

Q. Will I get more or less miles per gallon using ethanol fuel?

A. Vehicles using E10 will not experience any noticeable loss in miles per gallon.

Q. I filled up and then my 'Check Engine' light came on, is that from the E-10?

A. E-10 would not cause a 'Check Engine' light to come on or cause a car to run differently in any way.

If the customer insists that the fuel made their light come on or car run differently, fill out a customer incident report.

Q: Can I use ethanol in my motorcycle?

A: The use of E10 is approved for use by major motorcycle manufacturers including Harley-Davidson, Honda, Kawasaki, Suzuki and Yamaha. Harley-Davidson goes so far as to recommend the use of renewable, clean air fuels such as E10 because of their environmental and performance benefits.

Q: Can I use ethanol in my small engines?

A: E10 is perfectly acceptable in lawn mowers, weed eaters, chainsaws, ATVs and other small engines that run on ordinary unleaded gasoline. Generally, E10 may be used anywhere that ordinary unleaded gasoline is used — from lawn mowers to personal watercraft, from power equipment to marine engines. Check your owner's manual for specific information regarding your equipment.
